To welcome IIPPE guests, there will be a concert by 'E'Zezi – Gruppo Operaio' (workers' group), a band formed in Pomigliano d'Arco (Naples) in the mid-seventies, with the aim of fostering a vision of popular music different from that of the 'middle class', expressing a social critique of workers' exploitation. Working-class culture inspired both the birth of the band itself and the elaboration of their songs, which often feature issues related to industrial settings like those in the Vesuvius area, combining local music traditions to subaltern voices. The band's use of Neapolitan dialect in their songs expressly represents a means to challenge the established patterns of representation and the traditional forms of communication. E'Zezi describe themselves as an artistic-political force, actively part of all local workers' struggle since their formation.

Hourly Ticket: € 1.30. Valid for 90 minutes from the first validation.

Daily Ticket: € 3.70. Valid from 00.00 to midnight of the day of validation.

Weekend daily ticket: € 3.10. Valid on Saturday or on public holidays from 00.00 to midnight of the day of validation.

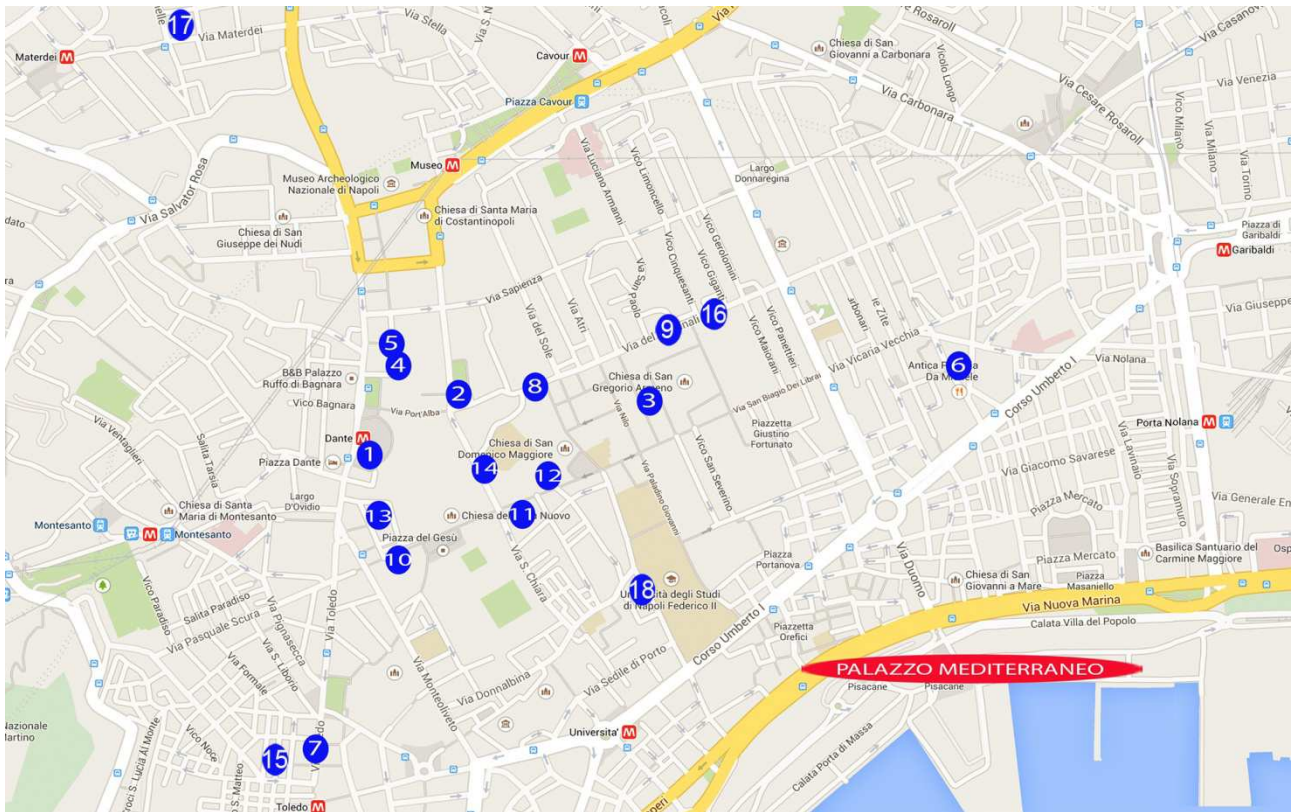

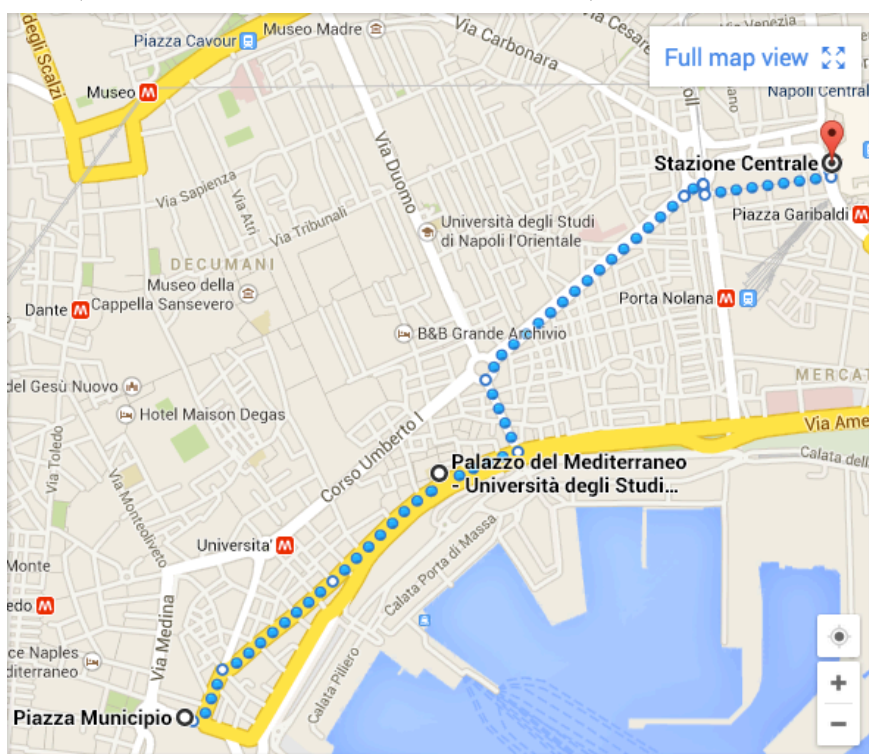

How to get to Naples:

There are two alternatives for travelling to Naples. One possibility is to fly directly to Naples Airport Capodichino, which is very close to downtown city. You can reach the centre of the city either by taxi or by bus. As for taxi rates, please note that you can choose flat fares upon request at the beginning of the trip. From/to Capodichino Airport/Central Station (nearby hotels – see below) the fare is 16 Euros while from/to Capodichino Airport/Piazza Municipio (nearby hotels – see below) the fare is 19 Euros. The complete city base rates can be checked here: http://www.consorziotaxinapoli.it/home_eng/. The bus service is called Alibus and links the airport to the city centre (Piazza Municipio and Piazza Garibaldi/Central Station are the stops closer to the hotels). It costs 3 Euros if bought at the airport (Sun Store Tabacchi) or 4 Euros if bought on board. Both the taxi and the Alibus stops are just outside the airport (Arrivals).

Another possibility is to fly to Fiumicino Airport, Rome, and take a train to the Termini (central) Station. The easiest way to reach Termini Station is to take the direct train Leonardo Express. It costs 14 Euros and covers the distance in 30 minutes (<http://www.rome-airport.info/in.html>). You can then change to the high-speed train (Freccia Rossa) to Naples. It takes 1h 10 minutes, with trains at least once per hour and up to 3 or 4 trains per hour in peak time. At normal fares the train costs 39/43 Euros, but good offers can be found upon early booking (19 or 29 Euros depending on when you book): www.trenitalia.com. Naples Central Station is located in the city centre with connections to the subway, the bus terminal and the taxi station.

Please note that most of the hotels indicated below are within walking distance either from Piazza Municipio or from the following metro stations (Line one – from Piazza Garibaldi/Central station): Università, Toledo, Dante, Museo.



Moving in Naples:

The ticket can be purchased in newsstands or cafes.

Proxy Configuration Instructions to Access University's WI-FI.

- **On Windows laptops:**

- If you are using **Internet Explorer:**

1. Click the *Tools* menu. Depending on your version of Internet Explorer, this may be in the standard menu bar, or it may be the gear icon in the top-right corner.
2. Select *Internet options*. Regardless of which menu you use, this option will be located at the bottom of the menu.
3. Click the *Connections* tab. Under the "Local Area Network (LAN) settings" header, click the "LAN settings" button. This will open another new window.
4. Enable the proxy settings. Check the box in the "Proxy server" section, and uncheck the "Automatically detect settings" box.
5. Enter the following information:

Address: **proxy.unior.it**

Port: **808**

6. Exit and open a web page. Insert the following:

User Name: **iippe**

Password: **iippe2014**

- If you are using **Firefox:**

1. Click the Firefox menu. This is located in the upper-left corner of the Firefox window.
2. Click *Options*.
3. Select the *Advanced options*. It is located at the top of the Options window on the far right.
4. Select the *Network* tab.
5. Click the *Settings* button at the top of the Network page in the Connections section.
6. Choose the *Automatic proxy configuration* option and insert the following:

7. Exit and open a web page. Insert the following:

User Name: **iippe**

Password: **iippe2014**

- If you are using **Chrome:**

1. Click the Chrome menu button. This is located at the top-right corner of the Chrome window, and looks like three horizontal bars.
2. Select *Settings*. This will open a new tab in your browser. Click the *Show advanced settings* link at the bottom of the page.

3. Click the *Change proxy settings* button. This is located in the Network section of the advanced settings. Clicking the button will open the *Internet Properties* window.
4. Click the *Connections* tab. Under the “Local Area Network (LAN) settings” header, click the “LAN settings” button. This will open another new window.
5. Enable the proxy settings. Check the box in the “Proxy server” section, and uncheck the “Automatically detect settings” box.
6. Enter the following information:

Address: **proxy.unior.it**

Port: **808**

7. Exit and open a web page. Insert the following:

User Name: **ippe**

Password: **ippe2014**

- **On Mac laptops:**

1. Click the Safari menu. Select *Preferences*, and then choose the *Advanced* option on the far right end of the toolbar.
2. Click the *Change Settings* button next to *Proxies*. This will open the Network section of the System Preferences screen.
3. Select your active network connection: **wi-fi-unior**
4. Click the *Advanced* button. Once the advanced menu opens, click the *Proxies* tab.
5. Select the *WEB Proxy (HTTP)* protocol. Make sure *Auto Proxy Discovery* is unchecked.
6. Enter the following details:

Web Proxy Server: **proxy.unior.it**

Port: **808**

7. Tick *Proxy server requires authentication* box and insert the following:

User Name: **ippe**

Password: **ippe2014**

- **On Android devices:**

1. Run *Settings* application.
2. Select *Wi-Fi*.
3. Connect to the following network (access point): **wi-fi-unior**
4. Long press on *connected* network, context menu will appear.
5. Select *Modify network config*.
6. Mark *Show advanced options* check box.
7. Scroll to proxy settings, select *Manual*, proxy options will appear.
8. Change *Proxy Host Name* to: **proxy.unior.it**
9. Similarly, change *Proxy Port* to: **808**

10. Exit Settings and open a web page (N.B. Use default browser!)

11. Authentication will be required; insert the following:

User Name: **ippe**

Password: **ippe2014**

- **On Apple devices:**

1. Run *Settings* application.
2. Select *Wi-Fi*.
3. Select the following network (access point): **wi-fi-unior**
4. Select *Info*.
5. Scroll down to the bottom of the page and select *Manual*.
6. Enter the following:

Server: **proxy.unior.it**

Port: **808**

7. With *Authentication* enabled, insert:

User Name: **ippe**

Password: **ippe2014**

8. Exit and open browser. You are now connected
